Sample Plan of Study

Peace Corps Fellows, ACED Fellows, and Peace Corps Master's International Students in Applied Economics fulfill requirements for a sequence in applied community and economic development, which are listed below. This list is subject to change.

Note that this sample plan of study presumes that students have been admitted without deficiencies. For admission without deficiencies, a student must have already successfully completed five courses: principles of economics, intermediate macroeconomics, intermediate microeconomics, calculus, and statistics. Although students may apply for either the Fall or Spring semesters, we prefer to consider applicants without deficiencies for the Fall semester (August start). We recommend that those with deficiencies apply for the Spring semester (January start).
